Frequently Asked Questions

How do I obtain Grant information, instructions and forms?

To obtain the grant process description, application instructions and the Grant Application Form, go to the **NPRHA.org** website.

Then Click --- **About the NPRHA**

Scroll down to “NPRHA Preservation Grants”

Then Click --- **Preservation Grants Site**

Download and save these documents to your computer:

- **NPRHA Grants Announcement and Process Description**
- **NPRHA Official Grant Application Form**

Print the **NPRHA Grants Announcements and Process Description**.

Fill out the **NPRHA Official Grant Application Form** using your computer.

What is the deadline for applying?

Applications for Grants may be made at any time. Those received on or before March 1 of any year will be evaluated for that year. Those received after March 1 will be evaluated for the following year.

Who can apply for a Grant?

Applicants must be: (1) Public bodies, (2) 501(c)(3) Non-profit organizations or (3) Individuals with an endorsement from a sponsor organization that is a public body or a 501(c)(3) Non-profit.

What is the maximum amount of a grant?

\$5,000

How many grants can I apply for?

Applicants are limited to one application per year. Applicants that have received grants in two consecutive years are disqualified from applying for a period of one year following the second award.

How often are grants awarded?

Grants are awarded annually following an evaluation period in March by the Grants Committee and approval by the NPRHA Board of Directors. The time to complete the process will vary depending on the number and complexity of the grants submitted.
